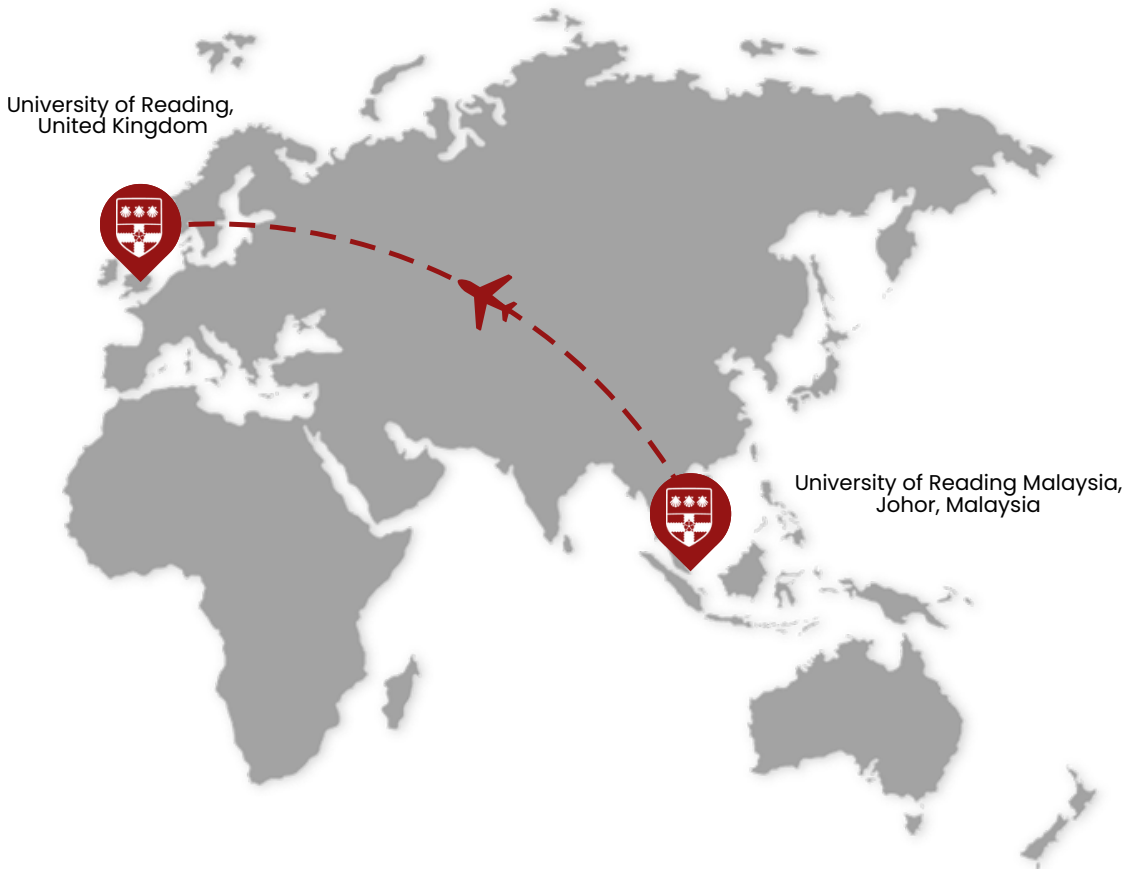

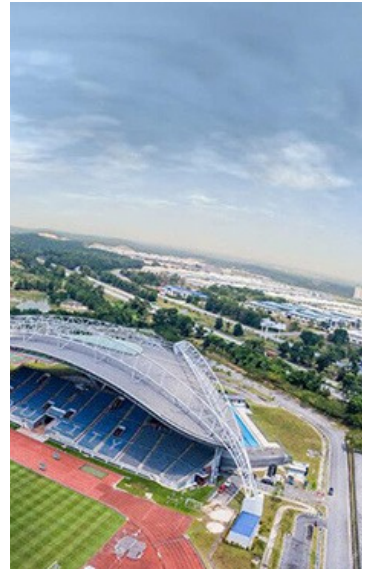
OUR LOCATION



EDUCITY ISKANDAR

EduCity Iskandar is a designated hub for education.

EduCity Iskandar in Johor is Asia's first multi-campus education city, purpose-built to create a vibrant ecosystem for learning, living, and growth. Spanning 305 acres, it brings together renowned international universities, research centres, sports facilities, and student accommodation within a single integrated environment. This unique setting gives students at the University of Reading Malaysia the advantage of studying in a world-class destination while enjoying the warmth and affordability of Malaysia.

At EduCity, student life goes beyond the classroom.

The EduCity Sports Complex, with its Olympic-sized swimming pool, stadium, indoor arena, and fitness facilities, ensures students have access to some of the best sporting and recreational infrastructure in the region.



ACCESSIBLE LOCATION

Getting to the University of Reading Malaysia at EduCity is simpler than you might think. Located in Iskandar Puteri, Johor, an area known for its rapid growth and close proximity to Singapore, the campus is well connected through public transport and shuttle services, making it convenient for both local and international students.

Major Transport Nodes:

Senai International Airport is about 20 minutes away by car. If using public transportation, there are bus, taxi or e-hailing options.

Larkin Sentral Bus Terminal, the main express bus hub in Johor Bahru, is about a 20-minute drive away. From there, e-hailing or local buses provide access to EduCity.

Taxi / E-hailing & Airport Access

If you prefer direct trips, e-hailing services (like Grab) are widely available. From Senai Airport to EduCity, for example, taxi or e-hailing rides typically take about 20–25 minutes.

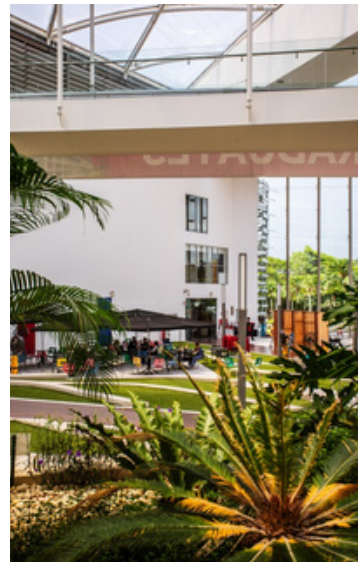


UoRM CAMPUS

Our impressive campus at EduCity covers an area of 27,000 square metres and is an integrated, self-contained space that combines flexible teaching, research and learning spaces with inspiring social spaces. The design for the campus made the finals in the World Architecture Festival Awards in 2013.



The Heartspace – the central parkland space between the two buildings, came from the idea to emulate the open, natural space of the University of Reading's Whiteknights campus in the UK, but to translate this for a tropical setting. The Heartspace is now a plant-filled space for students to relax and socialise. There is also an amphitheatre for talks, live music and events.

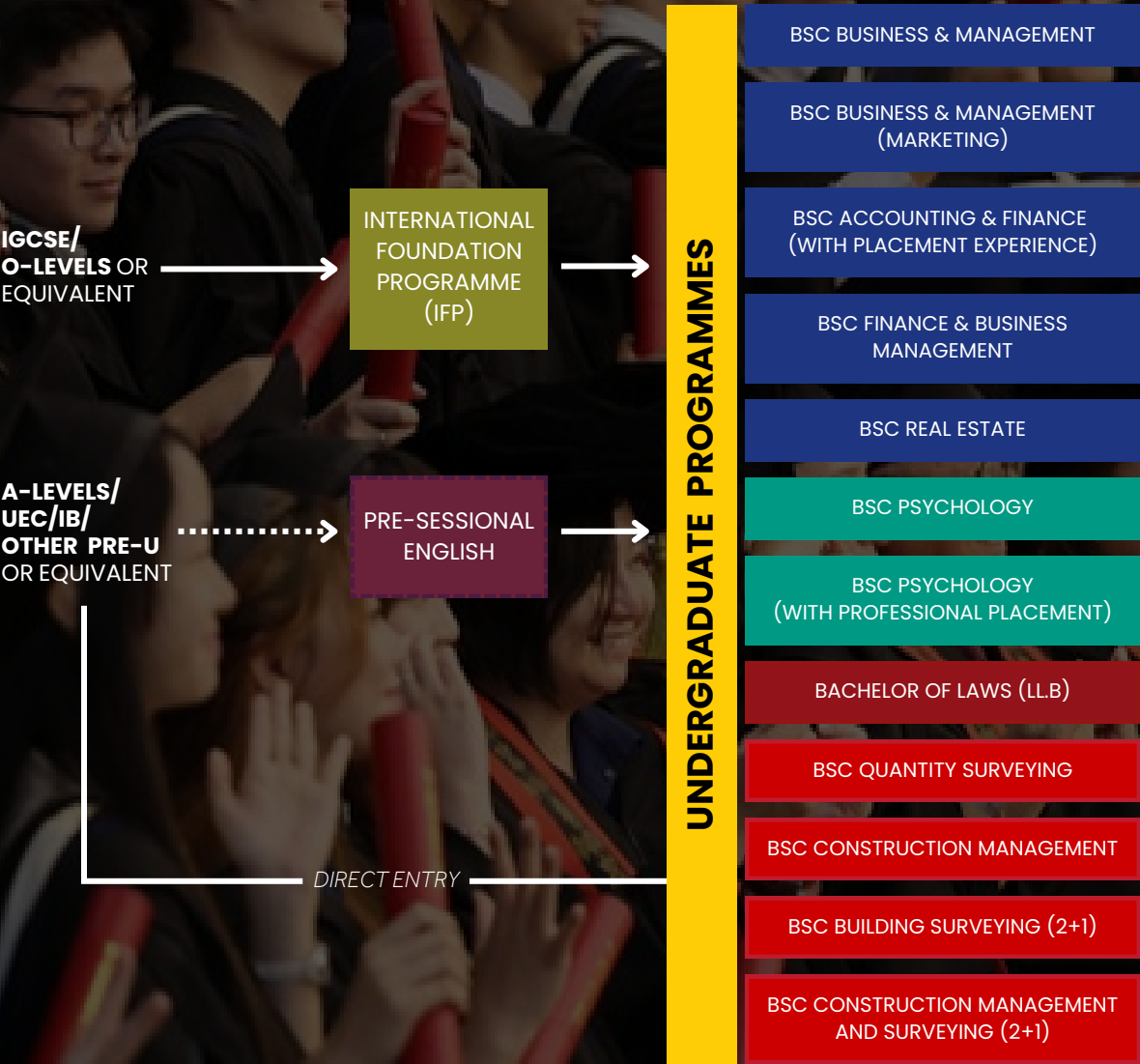

High Achiever's Scholarship

Students who demonstrate exemplary academic ability and results will automatically receive the High Achiever's Scholarship.

- Students eligible for the scholarship are entitled to a tuition fee waiver based on their academic performance and education level:

International Foundation Programme: 20 – 30% tuition fee waiver

Undergraduate Programmes: 15 – 30% tuition fee waiver

- Scholarship holders are required to complete 2 to 4 recognised tasks on an annual basis; failure to do so may result in scholarship withdrawal.
- Terms & conditions apply.

Alumni & Family Benefits

- Alumni bursary (10% on first year tuition fees from IFP to UG).
- Alumni bursary for children of alumni (10% on tuition fees for the first year at UoRM).
- Sibling benefit (10% on tuition fees for the first year at UoRM) – only eligible for the subsequent sibling(s).
- Family bursary for immediate family members of UoRM staff members (15% on tuition fees). T&Cs apply as per the Staff Handbook.

Note:

- A student is eligible to receive only **ONE TYPE** of financial benefit, whether it is a scholarship, bursary or incentive (except for an Early Bird waiver and a PSE rebate), whichever value is higher.
- Students receiving a Provost's Award or High Achiever's Scholarship must maintain 70% average to continue receiving their scholarship in Year 2 and beyond. Please note that rounding up of marks is not permitted.
- Based on Malaysian Government's latest update on 17 October 2025, the Sales Tax (SST) for tuition fees is calculated based on the net tuition fees paid (by academic year or by semester), after any scholarship, bursary or waiver (if any).

VISA GUIDE

VISA APPLICATION

STEP 1

Submit all required visa application documents for review by the university's International Office.

After reviewing the required documents, the International Office will issue the Visa Application invoice.

STEP 2

Make the visa application payment, payment proof to share with uorm-international@reading.edu.my and finance@reading.edu.my.

STEP 3

Wait for processing by the Malaysia EMGS (Education Malaysia Global Services) Application Centre, which takes approximately 7 to 14 working days.

You can also check the real-time status of your visa application through the EMGS site.

STEP 4

Once approved by EMGS, the application will be forwarded to the Malaysia Immigration Department for final student visa processing, which takes another 7 to 14 working days.

Important:

- While waiting for the E-VAL (Electronic Visa Approval Letter), applicants must not enter Malaysia on a tourist visa as this may affect the visa approval process.
- If the applicant is already in Malaysia under a tourist visa, they must exit the country and provide proof of the passport page showing the exit stamp to the International Office, which will then be submitted to the Malaysian Immigration.

STEP 5

Once the e-VAL is approved, the International Student Office will notify the applicant via email, or you may download the e-VAL from EMGS Hub mobile application. Please follow the Visa Application Checklist & Guidelines to complete the next steps:

- Obtain a Single-Entry Student Visa from the Malaysian Embassy or apply for an e-VISA from the Malaysian Immigration portal.
- Apply for a Malaysia Digital Arrival Card (MDAC) at least three days before arrival in Malaysia.
- After completing these steps, share the details of your flight ticket with the International Office.

STEP 6

Applicants may choose to stay in university-recommended accommodation or arrange their own accommodation.

IMPORTANT:

It is recommended to submit your course application materials at least two months before the intake month. Once you receive the official offer letter and pay the MYR 2,000 deposit, you may proceed with the student visa application.
