Graduates of this programme are also on track to attain the ICAEW Chartered Accountant (ICAEW ACA) qualification, a highly-respected professional competency in business and finance. ICAEW Chartered Accountants are valued for their specified, certified skill set and are some of the most in-demand professionals across a range of industries and sectors around the world.

Graduates will attain the ICAEW ACA when they complete the remaining study modules for the ICAEW ACA programme, and fulfil the required work experience for the ACA training agreement.

You will need to record 450 days of relevant 'on-the-job' work experience. You may be able to count the 12 months' Industry Placement towards your ACA training.

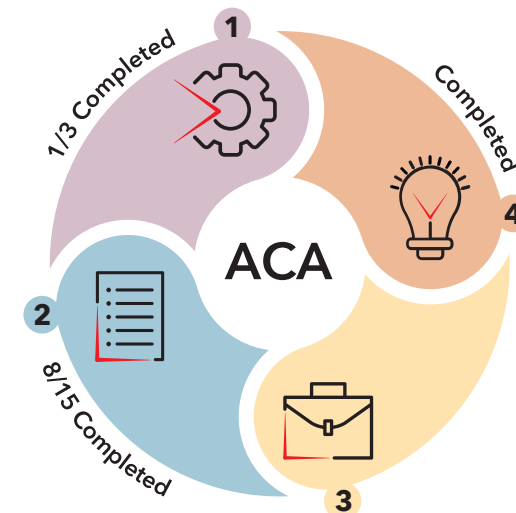

The ICAEW BFP designation also offers access to a range of information, training and services from ICAEW to support ongoing personal and professional development. These are elements that are critical for a successful career in business and finance.

PROGRAMME STRUCTURE
The 4-year degree programme combines technical learning, 1-year work experience and an understanding of ethics in business so that students obtain a critical grasp of the fundamentals, in a broader understanding of the business and finance environment.



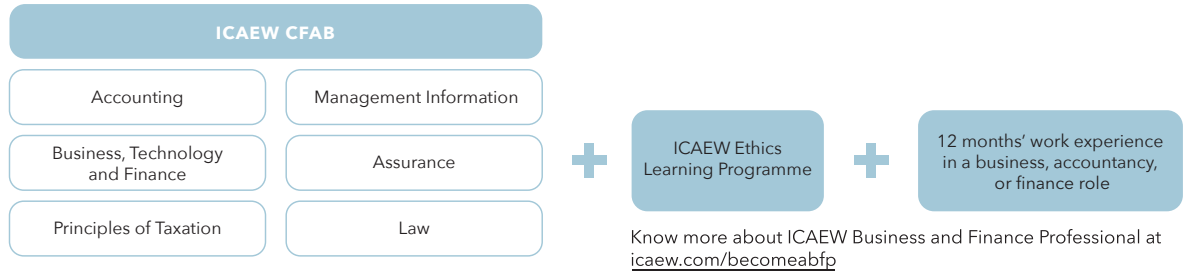

ICAEW BUSINESS AND FINANCE PROFESSIONAL



Students only need to sit and pass the ICAEW CFAB Accounting module. Five credit exemptions* can be applied for the following ICAEW CFAB modules:

- Management Information
- Business, Technology and Finance
- Assurance
- Principles of Taxation
- Law

The 12 months’ work experience is included in Henley UoRM industry placement experience.

This programme is only available for students who complete the 4-year degree at University of Reading Malaysia. Students who transfer to the University of Reading (UK) are not eligible for the ICAEW BFP designation under this programme.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- 1 Foundation in Business from University of Reading Malaysia
- 2 STPM / A-Levels BBB
Mathematics Grade A (SPM / GCSE / IGSCE)
- 3 UEC 14 points from 5 subjects excluding Chinese Language, and Bookkeeping and Accounts
- 4 International Baccalaureate 30 points overall including 5 in Standard Level (SL) Mathematics or an equivalent qualification recognised by the Malaysian Government, acceptable to the University

Yearly intakes are in September and January.
